- **PRODIGY** (PRAHD uh jee) *noun*
- an extremely talented child; an extraordinary accomplishment or occurrence

PROLIFIC

- PROLIFIC (proh LIF ik) *adjective*
- abundantly productive; fruitful or fertile

PROLIFERATE

- (proh LIF uh rayt) *verb*
- to spread or grow rapidly

PLETHORA

- PLETHORA (PLETH ur uh) *noun*
- an excess

MUNIFICENT

- **MUNIFICENT** (myoo NIF uh sunt) *adjective*
- very generous; lavish

SQUANDER

- SQUANDER (SKWAHN dur) *verb*
- to waste

AGGREGATE

- **AGGREGATE** (AG ruh gut) *noun*
- sum total; a collection of separate things mixed together
